❖ Results

- The Results Page should list all events with the format: Year – City Country.

Example: 2025 – Budapest (Hungary)

- Each listed event should be clickable.
- Clicking on an event should redirect the user to the PDF of that year's result.

The page should be dynamic, so adding future results follows the same pattern...

❖ How to Participate (Registration)

When a user clicks on the Registration button:

- A registration form should open immediately.
- The user must fill in the required details (such as Name, Email, Phone Number, City, etc.).
- Once the form is submitted, the data should be saved in the database.
- Additionally, all the details entered in the form must be sent to our official email address so that we are notified whenever someone registers.

❖ **SPORTS**

Under each sports subtab, the structure should be as follows:

1. **Basic Game Information**

Each page should contain simple and relevant information about the respective sport introduction

2. **Image Slider**

Each sport page should include a slider with approximately **4 to 5 images** related to that specific game.

The images must be manageable from the admin panel (add, edit, delete).

3. **Rules of the Game Section**

There should be a **clickable button or tab** labelled “View Rules” or “Game Rules.”

When the user clicks on it, the rules of that specific game should open on the same page.

All content, including game information, rules, and slider images, should be editable from the admin panel.

❖ A Week in a Glance

For the “**A Week in a Glance**” section, we would like a structure similar to the format used in the GFF “Facilities – Awards and Ceremony” section.

The format should be as follows:

- First: Information content (text description)
- Then: Photo slider
- Next: Opening Ceremony information
- Then: Opening Ceremony photo slider
- Next: Sports Competitions information
- Then: Sports Competitions photo slider

This pattern (Information + Photo Slider) should continue as needed.

Most importantly, the admin panel should allow us to:

- Add multiple sections as required
- Add text content for each section
- Upload photo sliders for each section
- Add or remove sections anytime
- Reorder sections if needed

We should have the flexibility to add as many sections (with content + photo sliders) as required.

❖ Contact Us

I need the Contact Us section exactly as per the attached reference design.

- The colours should match our logo colours.
- The first section should have the heading “GET IN TOUCH” with three contact icons (Phone, Email, Address).
- The second section should have a dark background contact form with a two-column layout.
- The submit button must be in the primary logo colour.
- The design should be fully responsive, modern, and clean across all devices (mobile, tablet, and desktop).

❖ Photo Gallery

1. Gallery Structure (Year-Based Albums)

- The gallery must be organized into Year-based albums (e.g., 2025 Photos, 2026 Photos, etc.).
- Each year should appear as a separate album card on the main gallery page.
- When a user clicks on a specific year, it should open and display all photos for that selected year.

2. Year Sorting Logic (Important)

- Albums must be displayed in descending order (latest year first).

Eg display order:

- 2026
- 2025
- 2024
- If the admin adds a new higher year (e.g., 2027), it should automatically appear at the top.
- If the admin adds an older year (e.g., 2023 after 2025 & 2024 already exist), it should automatically appear in the correct chronological position (at the bottom in this case).
- Sorting must be automatic from the backend.

Backend Logic:

- Year must be stored as a numeric field.
- Albums should be sorted using:

Order By Year DESC:

- No manual positioning should be required.

3. Album Page Layout

Inside each year album:

- Photos should be displayed in a 4-column grid layout per row (desktop view).
- Proper spacing and clean alignment.
- Fully responsive layout

4. Slider Navigation Control

Inside each year album:

- Add left and right arrow navigation controls.
- Add dot indicators to show image position.
- Active dot should use the primary logo colour.
- Smooth sliding transition effect.
- Navigation must be fully responsive and user-friendly.

5. Image Hover Effects

Please add modern and attractive hover effects on gallery images:

- Slight zoom-in effect on hover.
- Soft shadow effect.

The design should look clean, modern, and professional.

6. Backend Requirements

Admin panel should allow:

- Create new Year album.
- Upload multiple images under each year.
- Edit or delete albums.
- Delete individual images.

Allowed Image Formats:

- .png
- .jpg
- .jpeg
- Proper file validation must be implemented.
- Image size optimization recommended.

FISEC-FICEP

FISEC: -

Fédération Internationale Sportive de l'Enseignement Catholique (FISEC) is an international school sports organisation recognised by the **International Olympic Committee (IOC)**. Founded in **1948**, FISEC has a rich legacy of more than seven decades dedicated to the promotion of international school sports.

FISEC organises an annual international multi-sport event known as the **FISEC Games**, often referred to as the **World School Games**. The federation's members consist of national sports and school sports organisations that promote FISEC activities within their respective countries and participate in the FISEC Games.

The primary objective of FISEC is the organisation of the FISEC Games each year. Participation in the Games is open to FISEC member organisations and potential members. The competition is conducted for the **15–17 years age group**, for both **boys and girls**.

The sports programme of the FISEC Games includes:

- **Individual Sports:**
Athletics (Track & Field), Swimming, Table Tennis, Tennis
- **Team Sports:**
Basketball, Futsal, Handball, Volleyball, Football (Soccer)

The final selection of sports is determined based on the preliminary entries received from participating countries.

The FISEC Games are hosted by one of the member organisations and are usually held in the **second week of July**. The Games are conducted over a period of **five days** and, in addition to the sports competitions, place strong emphasis on **cultural exchange, education, and international friendship**.

FICEP: -

The FICEP is an international sports association acting on the basis of ethical ideals of Christianity, advocating the Christian ideas of man in sports and communities.

The FICEP understands sports as a means of development for each individual on the basis of the message of the Gospel regarding physical, mental, social, ethical and cultural aspects. In addition

to that the FICEP communicates ideals like fairness, tolerance, charity or respect of life via the means of sports. The organisation assists young people by offering them the possibility to carry out sports activities on an international basis and to engage for the advancement of nations in a globalized world.

As an international organisation the FICEP wants to stay abreast of changes in Europe and all over the world by remaining unsettled for all cultures and nations. Despite of abilities, age, health or sickness, race or colour the FICEP wants to act as an advocate of humans in the world of sports and confirms the presence of Christianity and the church in today's world.

The FICEP has its head office in Paris and an administrative office in Vienna. The yearly general assembly is the decision-making institution of the FICEP. Every year it organizes – in the week after Easter – a convention lasting several days and focusing on the general assembly. Within the framework of the convention committee meetings take place in the areas of sports, youth and pastoral. The board of directors is elected every four years.

History of FISEC Games

FISEC (Fédération Internationale Sportive de l'Enseignement Catholique) was founded in 1948 to promote the importance of physical activity and sport in the physical, human, and Christian education of young people, particularly within Catholic education.

It was initiated in 1946 by representatives from France, Belgium, and the United Kingdom, with the official establishment taking place in Brussels in January 1948. The first FISEC Games were held in Monte-Carlo in 1948.

Over the years, more countries joined, girls' Games were introduced in 1959, and mixed Games began in 1980. Since 1998, FISEC has continued with Summer Games only. The organization has been recognized by the International Olympic Committee since 1995.

Since 2011, FISEC has collaborated with FICEP, officially formalizing their partnership in 2017 to jointly organize international Games.
